

THE ROAD TO EXPLORA IN EL CHALTÉN

El Chaltén is a small mountain town in the Los Glaciares National Park, about 218 km north of El Calafate.

Our lodge is in Estancia Los Huemules, 17 km north of El Chaltén.

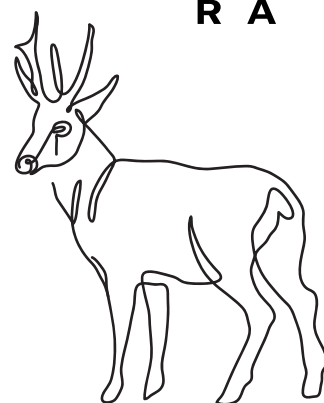
⚠ IMPORTANT

Given there is no phone reception on the route, you must contact our team before starting your trip to request the padlock key to enter the lodge.

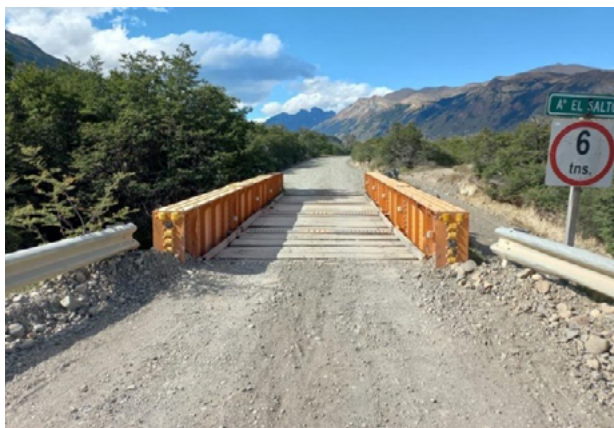
3 4 km after passing the gate you will reach an orange bridge across the Eléctrico River.

Puente 3: Río Eléctrico – 15.5 Km



1 Leave El Chaltén heading north. Take the road toward Lago del Desierto.

Bridge 1: Arroyo del Salto - 4.5 km (10 minutes after El Chaltén)



4 Continue for 1 km after crossing the orange bridge and you will come to a wooden gate to the left, just before another small bridge, also orange.

On the left hand side of the road is the entrance to 'Los Huemules' reserve entrance. The wooden gate has a padlock with a combination to open it, which is sent to each traveler personally at the time of booking.



2 After 12 km (about 25 min) you will pass through a gate that says: 'Límite norte del Parque Nacional los Glaciares.'

Puente 2: Arroyo Blanco – 14.5 Km (Doesn't have a sign)



ONCE INSIDE THE RESERVE:

5 Stay to the left for 2.1 km and follow the gravel road for 3 km until reaching the slope that takes you to the Explora lodge in El Chaltén.
